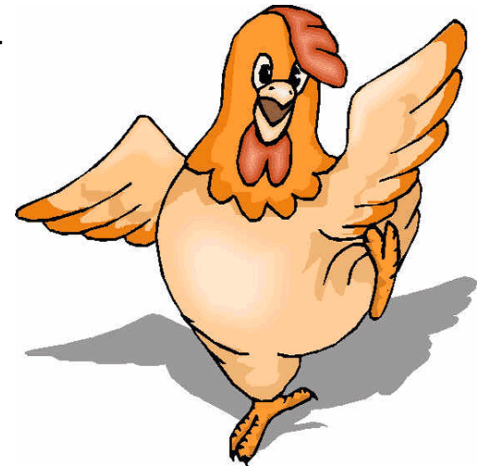

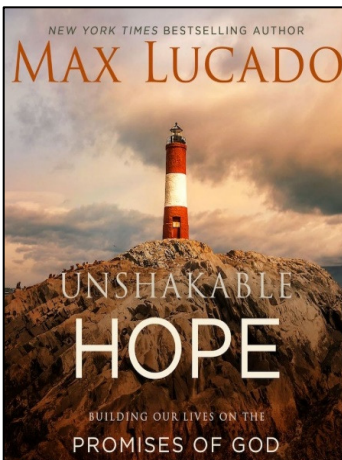
CTK Summer Play:
