Paycheck Protection Plan (PPP) Loan: Has been approved and monies have already been wired into the church bank account.

Videos: Pastor Kelly is posting videos on Facebook. Rachel will be trained to put these videos onto CTK's website.

COVID-19 Pandemic Update:

- Coming back to church: Outdoor services (weather permitting) for the month of June.
 We need to ensure that everyone still stays at least 6' apart (except for individual family groups).
- Time frame? Month of June? Summer?
- Andy (Living Hope): We can't rush this too quickly. Living Hope had a discussion (on 5/18). How can we work together? How can we come closer together? Share Sunday services. LH will continue hosting drive-in services. Outdoor service at CTK (West lawn band plays from inside, speakers/screens outside). No service in bad weather. Try this out for June if doesn't work can re-address or continue if it works out.
- Benefits getting people together from both congregations; stress relief for Pastor Kelly.
- Pre-record services can be available at normal church service time. Probably not a longterm possibility, but can work for the short-time for now.
- PK recommendation 6/7 9a LH, CTK recorded. 6/14 Athirst "outside" live w/ LH recorded, 21st recorded @ CTK, drive-in @ LH, 28th Athirst outside. Keeping same worship times at both congregations? Live option w/ live communion every week. All live (outdoor) services @ 9am. Live recordings (not attended) at 10:30. Schedule sent in church e-mail from Rachel on 5/27.

Restrictions/Guidelines for worship on CTK lawn:

- Masks are recommended
- Bathrooms are discouraged (limit 1 person at a time?)
- Hand sanitizer & masks will be made available
- mark 6' marks in grass(?).
- Download-able bulletin will be available.
- Screen will be available outside for people to follow along. No paper bulletins

Other Business:

- Leak in Sanctuary: Drainage situation is not sustainable. Jim does not have spare time to look into this. But, something needs to be sooner rather than later. Jim will work w/ Rachel who will make calls.
- **Block party:** scheduled for June has been cancelled. E&O will look at possibly rescheduling for September.
