# Addressing Recent Projects at the Church:

- Roof work has been completed
- Drainage problem at sanctuary door has been fixed, but landscape needs to be addressed. UPDATE 9/18 - landscaping was completed 9/18 thanks to a donation from the family of a Prime Horizon client!
- Patio project Prime Horizon received a donation to cover the cost of cement for new patio
- Flooring project Asbestos was found to be present in old flooring below the current flooring. Asbestos scheduled to be removed 9/12. Painting will then take place before new flooring goes in. \*\*Need help with painting on 9/19 and 9/26 contact Ellen Smith
- Back lot is in rough shape. This has been tabled until after the winter

### Committee Reports:

<u>Vision Committee:</u> Moving forward this fall with Joint Discernment team (CTK & Living Hope working together). Chris Lear is the head. There are 5 members from each church. First meeting is scheduled for the 1st or 2nd week of October. Goal is to look at MSPs for both churches and get everything in place for the call process in the spring. MSP for each church is fairly the same. They plan to hold monthly congregational meetings to be as transparent as possible. Committee is open to anyone else that wants to join. Minutes will posted for each congregation. "Call" process was reviewed with Leadership Team.

<u>Worship & Music Committee:</u> Concentrating on traditional services every 2 weeks. Every other pew will be roped off and a sprayer has been obtained to disinfect sanctuary; sprayer to be shared with Living Hope. Furnace filters will be changed out and will run fan through furnace/AC unit during service. Looking for volunteers for music.

<u>Fellowship:</u> No report. Coffee hour will be planned to get people meeting, with social distancing. (Trunk or Treat is scheduled for 10/18 at noon, Living Hope parking lot)

<u>Evangelism & Outreach:</u> Community Picnic was not as well attended as expected. Was still a great time for those there. Food and worship were good. Online visitor form has been set up. Cards will be put in the pews directing them to the website to sign in. An email will be sent directly to Pastor Kelly who will forward it on to Rachel and E&O. Has been up for one month already. No events scheduled until Christmas.
