**Review of February Meeting Minutes:** Motion by Fred to approve the minutes. Second by Becki. All approve, none opposed; motion passes.

**Treasurer's Report**: Review and discussion of Treasurer's Report. Fred makes a motion to log Pastor Clare's housing allowance. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mark: clarification - on Feb 9, 2021 Council approved housing allowance for Pastor Clare to be 9k annually (\$750/month). All in favor; none opposed – motion passes. Mark moves to approve the Treasurer's Report, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ellen. All in favor; none opposed – motion passes.

### **Old Business:**

- **1. Call Process/Discernment Team**: 3<sup>rd</sup> version of corrected MSP was submitted. Awaiting review by the Synod team.
- 2. Giving Tracking: 2020 annual giving summaries went out.
- **3.** Cost Reduction Status: Fire alarm system has been updated & installed. A card will be made up and placed next to the alarm panel with instructions. The room where the water heater is located has a water detector on the floor and freeze sensor that sends an alert to and was free from the insurance company.
- **4. Leadership Team:** Eventually Pastor will be taking more of a leading role in this. Last meeting wasn't very tactical, more strategic.
