Fellowship Hall- was rented for an April 1 birthday party. All went well.

Stainless Steel table was purchased by Stone Soup for the kitchen

New Business

Gutters- NE corner gutters are leaking and need to be looked at.

Sidewalk- section that sank on walkway from parking lot needs to be repaired.

Rummage Sale- will run in mid-June for two weeks.

Rental policy- needs to be revised to include the Fellowship Hall – Sanctuary rental \$250, Council Room rental \$50, Fellowship Hall rental \$125

Blue Jean Sunday- May 21 to clean inside and outside after worship. Will be followed by a light lunch. There will be no Bible study that day.

60th Anniversary- CTK will turn 60 on Nov. 19, 2023. Discussion on using event as a fundraiser. Suggest giving \$6, \$60, \$600 or \$6,000.

Endowment Fund- also talked about setting up an Endowment Fund. The ELCA has a person who can direct us on the process.
