#### **Continuing Education**

Last week, I spent three days at Lutherdale camp in Elkhorn for the Greater Milwaukee Synod's Fall Leadership Conference. Our speaker was The Rev. Canon Stephanie Spellers, and it was a great time of practicing difficult conversations across differences, exploring spiritual practice of evangelism through listening and curiosity, and of course, great fellowship time with colleagues. I'm particularly grateful this year that our synod is committed to offering childcare at these synod-wide events. This was the first time we've taken advantage of it, and it was wonderful for Christin and I to both be able to participate in this conference.

Coming up, I'll be attending a mandatory synod boundaries education workshop in Wauwatosa on November 7, and a free Siebert workshop on avoiding burnout in Milwaukee on November 14 (No, I don't feel especially burned out, but I'm pretty sure that's the time you're supposed to learn good practices to avoid it!). Our Christmas Eve services will be 4:00 pm at CTK and 7:00 pm at LH. Christmas Day will be a joint 9:30 service at CTK. Sunday, December 29, will be a joint 9:30 lay-led lessons & carols service at Living Hope.
