**Treasurer's Report-**

Year to date contribution income as of June 19 is \$60,873. Year to date expenses are \$67,464, which includes \$7,696 in expenses for last year's accessible door project. Current mortgage balance is \$53,276.

Ellen moved to accept the Treasurer's Report, seconded by Fred. Motion carried.

**Pastor's Report**

- Vacation Bible School included 84 kids, of whom 45 were from Here We Grow and 39 from the churches and wider community (a significant increase from the 9 involved last year!) Financially, VBS was paid for with donations from congregation members, Thrivent Action Team grants, and participant fees, resulting in a surplus of over \$350, which will be distributed with \$100 to Living Hope, \$100 to Christ the King, and the balance being gifted to Breaking the Chains Church.
- Thank you to everyone who helped with Vacation Bible School and the joint Sunday carnival worship service!
- Pastor Daniel will be gone for several Sundays this summer. Supply pastors have been found to lead worship. August 17 will be a lay-led service without communion. Thank you to Fred for sharing a message that day.
